Budget Assumptions for 2021 Budget

Income Assumptions:

- Our Church's Wider Mission (OCWM) is expected to remain the same as 2020, with the exception of additional dollars from dually aligned and newly affiliated congregations in the NJ Association
- The momentum achieved by Friends of the Conference in 2019 and 2020 is expected to continue into 2021
- **A grant is expected to allow the CAC to cover planned expansion in financial / accounting operations**

Expense Assumptions:

- Salary expense has increased to reflect:
 - 1.6% increase, in keeping with CAC salary guidelines
 - Coverage for Marvin Silver sabbatical
- **Expenses for part time Finance Manager and retainer for legal assistance**
- Beginning to search for settled ACM
- Reduction in travel costs as more meetings are virtual
- Funding for lower costs for General Synod (virtual) and CAC Annual Meeting (may be hybrid)
- **Increased funding for ministerial excellence initiatives**
- **Increased funding for anti-racism initiatives**

Note – Those in **bold** relate to the implementation of strategic objectives

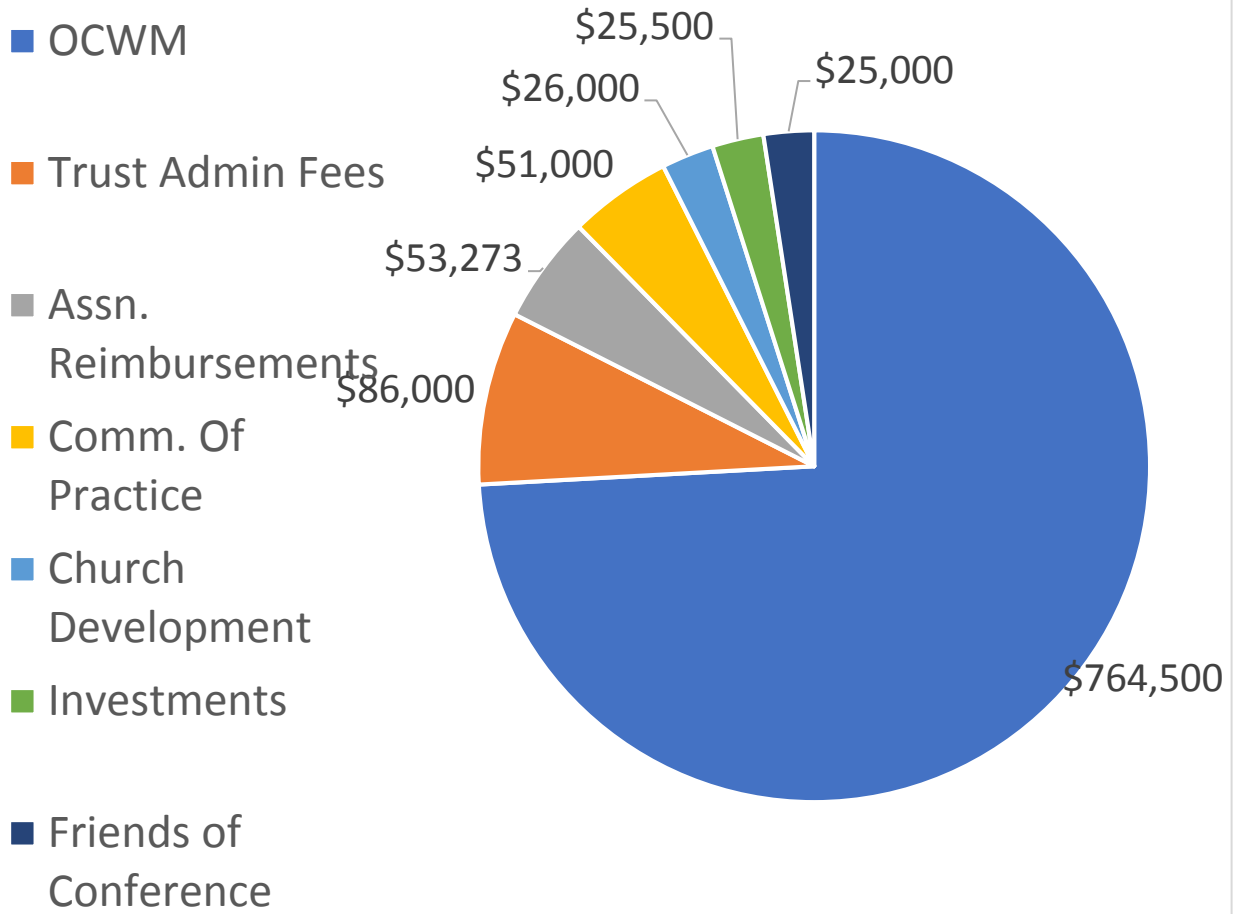
